To this end, Crestliner starts with 100% rivet-free hull bottoms. Hulls that are welded together for smooth aesthetic lines but more importantly, a high strength-toweight ratio. Almost twice that of fiberglass. Less weight means less power is required to achieve equivalent performance and that means lower costs.

To complete this sleek hull, it is sent through a series of acid and etch baths, rinsed and then baked. Acrylic enamel paint is meticulously applied and the boat is sent back into the oven to bake for 15 minutes at 410°F. The result is a tough, long lasting and beautiful paint finish that is warranted for a full 2 years (which is 2 years longer than most other manufacturers).

The most obvious advantages the SST II (Space Saver Transom\*) has to offer are increased cockpit space, reduced engine noise and top storage. But you'll really appreciate what this innovation does for the performance. Then there are a host of small attributes that make boat ownership a lot of fun. Things you'd probably never notice unless they weren't there.

- Like 3/4" marine grade flooring instead of 1/2."
- Metal underfloor backup plates for the seat bases.
- Seat hinges that are engineered without dangerous pinch points.
- Welded stainless steel bow rails.
